Horse and Rider Eligibility

Now that the competition season is in full swing again and results for the first two championships are coming in, we would like to remind all competitors that it is the responsibility of every rider to check the eligibility of themselves and their horse(s) to take part in any BRC competition. It has come to light recently that a rider knowingly took part in a competition for which they were ineligible. This rider had to face a BRC disciplinary committee and was suspended for six months.

We will be utilising the skills of some of our National Executive Committee members to help us check the eligibility of competitors and their horses. Chefs D'equipe and/or riders may therefore receive phone calls from our Area 19 representative; Jane Fisher or from our Area 7 representative: Rosemary Batten. They may have checked your horse's details against the relevant disciplines records and come across a duplicate name or similar details. They may call for clarification of the owner, age or colour of the horse and will then report back to the Competitions Department at Abbey Park in order that we can deal with those ineligible competitors or teams accordingly. We will recalculate the results if necessary and may have to disqualify an individual or team and pass the place down to the next eligible competitor/s.

VOSA Horse Lorry and Vehicle Checks

It has been brought to our attention that VOSA are intending to target horse lorries this year, particularly vehicles belonging to studs, livery yards, producers etc for driving without an Operators Licence. They will be heavily targeting 7.5t vehicles with regards to weight etc. An Area 19 official who was stopped recently said that VOSA had been operating from two depots within a ten mile radius of the M5.



Any private HGV horse lorry driver must use a tachograph and be able to produce the previous 28 days worth of driving records or work records, ie a diary. One of the problems seems to be that VOSA are not being consistent. In one area a driver was told that a diary was not a good enough record of hours worked - remember even if your work doesn't involve driving a lorry you must still be able to show that you have had the required rest periods and that they should have filled in the back of a tacho chart with Monday, Tuesday etc and the hours of work up until the last weekly rest. However another officer was quite happy with the diary.

Horse Rider SOS

Smart app for smart riders

An exciting and innovative new app, designed to make hacking safer is now available to riders.

HorseRiderSOS is an alerting tool which sends a panic message to your emergency contact containing your GPS position in the event of a fall or an accident. Simple to use, you just activate the app before heading off on your hack leaving your smartphone to do the rest.

Your activity is monitored in 'tracking mode' as you ride and in the event of you becoming unseated, injured or unconscious, the app recognises that you are no longer moving and will enter 'Alert mode' and send a message to your chosen contact.

Thanks to the GPS capability of your smart-phone, once an alert has been triggered, your exact position can be detected so that you can be found without delay. False alarms are prevented by a built in fail-safe mechanism so that alerts are only sent after a pre-determined user-defined period of inactivity. Once 'Alert mode' has been activated, the rider is notified and is then able to over-ride the system if it is not a genuine emergency.

2012 BRC Rulebook Amendments

If any of you have been looking for the numbers to qualify for the Novice Horse Trials and Challenge in the 2012 rulebook, then you may not be able to find them as they have been inadvertently missed from the usual appendix (10). The correct numbers to qualify for the Novice Horse Trials and Novice Challenge are: 1 – 12 teams starting: 1 team qualifying, 13 – 20: 2, 21 or more then 3 teams will qualify alongside the highest placed rider in each arena (horse trials only) not part of a qualifying team.



Entries are coming in now for qualifiers thick and fast. Please make sure that your teams horses are all eligible to compete before you enter them. They have to be eligible at the close of prelim entry. Any points or winnings gained after this time may be disregarded, unless they have made a recent application to downgrade, which was granted on the proviso that the horse was not re-registered with the relevant discipline.

May I also mention that downgrading applications need to be in at least two weeks before the close of prelim entry in order that we have enough time to make a decision on the application in advance of the entries being made. Downgrading must be granted before the close of preliminary entries.

For those competitors taking part in the Combined Training, please note the new addition to rule G6.3 that states 'No horse or pony may compete in a Novice or higher dressage test followed by a Prelim test in the same competition year.' This includes competitors taking part in the Combined Training for 2012.
